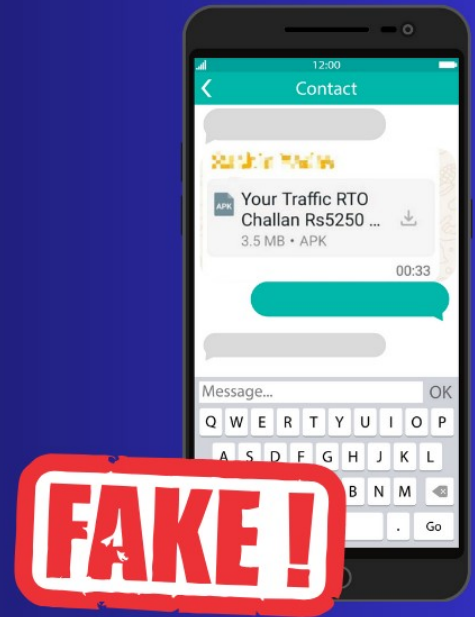




## CYBER JAGROOKTA DIWAS – November 2025

Cyber criminals are spreading a fake app named “RTO e-Challan.apk” via WhatsApp. It looks like an official traffic challan notice — but once installed, it steals your data, hijacks WhatsApp, and drains bank accounts!



### What to look out for ?

- Message shows your vehicle number or an urgent “traffic challan” link.
- File name: RTO e-Challan.apk (Android installer).
- Comes from WhatsApp contacts who may themselves be compromised.

#### Don'ts

- Don't click on WhatsApp links claiming you have a new challan.
- Don't download “.apk” files — they are not from Play Store.
- Don't trust messages even if they come from known contacts — their accounts might be hacked.

#### Do's

- Verify challans only at [echallan.parivahan.gov.in](http://echallan.parivahan.gov.in)
- Install apps only from the official Play Store
- Turn on Two-Step Verification on WhatsApp
- Keep your phone's security updates enabled
