WHY AND WHAT IS THE SCHEME?

Fructifying the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister, an on-line platform 'Anubhav Portal' was launched in March, 2015 for building up a digitised database of good governance legacy through sharing of experiences (Anubhav) by retiring and retired government employees.

11,030 write-ups have been published, out of which, 78 write-ups from across Government of India have been conferred with the 59 prestigious Anubhav Awards and 19 Jury Certificates in 7 Anubhav Awards Ceremonies.

- Recognition of your rich and varied contribution and suggestions for further referral by the Government machinery to further the cause of good governance, administrative reforms and effective public service delivery mechanism in the future.
 - Invitation to monthly Anubhav Awardees' Speak webinar series for sharing experiences, attended from hundreds of locations across country.


WHO CAN SUBMIT ANUBHAV?

Employees/Pensioners of Central Government, Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) and Public Sector Banks (PSBs)

WHAT IS THE TIME LIMIT?

The employees who are going to retire in next 8 months or the pensioners who have retired within the period not more than 3 years.

HOW TO SUBMIT WRITE-UP ON PORTAL



WHAT SHOULD COMPRISE YOUR ANUBHAY?

- Rich experiences that depict best practices, innovations and any good work experienced during service
- The parameters of marking system applicable to your pay scale should be covered.
- Suggestions for good governance in constructive manner.

WHO PUBLISHES YOUR SUBMITTED ANUBHAY?

After verification of the content by the HOO, the write-up is approved for publication by the HOD of the concerned Ministry/Department/Organization.

HOW ARE THE ANUBHAV WRITE-UPS EVALUATED?

- 2-tier evaluation is conducted by the DoPPW.
- 05 best Anubhav write-ups are selected for the prestigious Anubhav Awards (Medal, Certificate and Cash prize of Rs. 10,000)
- Another 10 outstanding Anubhav write-ups are conferred the acclaimed Jury Certificates (Medal and Certificate.)
- The national Anubhav award winners are felicitated by Hon'ble MOS (PP) at a national level event annually.

ELIGIBILITY

- Employees/Pensioners of Central Government, Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) and Public Sector Banks (PSBs) are eligible for submitting their write ups. The concerned administrative Ministry/Department under which CPSE/PSB falls, will manage the submission and publication of write-up.
- The employees who are going to retire in next 8 months or the pensioners who have retired within the period not more than 3 years can submit their write-ups.

TIME PERIOD & DISTRIBUTION

All Anubhav write ups published on the Anubhav Portal between the period 1st April, 2024 and 31st March, 2025 will be considered for the Anubhav Awards/Jury Certificates, 2025.

CDA pay scale is for Central govt. employees while equivalent pay scale in IDA /PSB Bank will be applicable to PSU/Bank employees. The pay scale wise division of the 05 Anubhav Awards and 10 Jury Certificates is as under:




Instructions for submitting write-ups of Anubhav


- 1. Enter your Full Name (Title, Name).



PROCESS OF PUBLICATION OF ANUBHAV WRITE-UP

- Nominated HOO and HOD verify the content of the write-up.
- It is ensured that the write-up does not contain details contrary to the 'declarations' as mentioned on the Anubhav portal.
- The final authority to publish the write-up is HOD of concerned Ministry/Department/Organization

PROCESS AFTER PUBLICATION

- Published write-up is subjected to 2-tier examination process by DOPPW
- Marks are assigned as per the marking system
- O5 Best write-ups are selected for Anubhav Awards and other 10 outstanding for Jury Certificates.
- Anubhav Award Winner: Medal, Certificate and Cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-
- Jury Certificate winner: Medal and Certificate
- The winners will be conferred by Hon'ble MOS(PP) at the national level event.
