



BIN [Bank Identification Number] **ATTACKS**

Most international transactions do not require an OTP for verification.

The first six to eight digits of your debit or credit card are your Bank identification Number(BIN). Fraudsters use high-speed software to "guess" your full card number, expiry date, and CVV.

The goal is to find a valid card combination for high-value unauthorized purchases.



Ways to Prevent BIN Attacks

● Keep international transaction disable when not in use

Set Up Real-Time transaction alerts ●

● Use Virtual Cards & set transaction limit

Report any unauthorized transactions immediately ●

If suspicious, report the incident immediately to 1930 or www.cybercrime.gov.in
