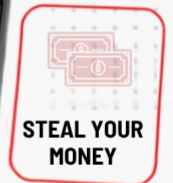

SCAMMERS ARE JUST ONE CALL AWAY!

Scammers are using YouTube Channels to spread fake customer care numbers for banks, telecom, e-commerce, and payment services. Calling these numbers can lead to financial fraud, data theft, or remote access scams.

Scammers post fake customer care numbers on YouTube and lure you into calling. **One call can cost you everything!**

HOW SCAMMERS TRICK YOU



They post fake customer care numbers on YouTube .



You call the number thinking it's official support.



Scammers pretend to help and gain your trust.



They ask for OTP, card details, remote access or personal info.



They steal your money and compromise your accounts.

HOW TO STAY SAFE

✓ OFFICIAL SOURCES

Always find the official customer care number on the Bank's official website or app. Follow official social media handles of the bank.

✓ VERIFY NUMBERS

Never trust numbers shown in Reels, videos, comments or unverified websites, Social media.

✓ PROTECT CREDENTIALS

Never share OTP, PINs, passwords or card details with anyone.

✓ BLOCK ACCESS

Do not give remote access to anyone (AnyDesk, TeamViewer, Quick Support, etc.).

Report suspicious videos and block/unsubscribe the channel immediately.
