




MALVERTISING

Looks Like an Ad.
Acts Like Malware.

Malvertising is the use of online advertising to spread malware. Attackers plant malicious ads in ad networks to spread malware—often appearing on trusted sites or as sponsored search results, where users expect safe content.



How to Protect Yourself from Malvertising

Be Wary of Unexpected Ads

Be cautious on unfamiliar websites and close pop-ups immediately. Enable pop-up blocker.

Be careful with Redirects

If a website unexpectedly redirects you, close the tab right away.

Keep Your Software Updated

Ensure up-to-date with the latest security patches.

Avoid Clicking Spam Links

Directly Access Websites, Instead of clicking on ads.
