576 with ₹100+cr income, 161 new entrants in FY25

The Centre on Monday said there were 576 individuals who had disclosed a gross income of more than Rs 100 crore during financial year 2024-25 (assessable year 2025-26), with 161 added during the year.

The additions during the year also mark the highest number in at least four years. While it is a small fraction of around 81 crore who filed returns in 2024-25, govt is drawing comfort from the rise in number of taxpayers who are disclosing higher income. **P 13**

CJP accuses govt of preaching promises, warns of protests

Says Protesters Being Arrested, Cases Registered

New Delhi: With reports of protesters across the country being detained and arrested, CJP on Monday accused the Centre of 'breaching' its assurances on protecting them from police action after the July 25 agreement that led to the withdrawal of its litigation.

CJP representatives warned that they were being 'forced' to resume protests if the central govt failed to FULL COVERAGE: P 5, 7, 8, 12

Addressing a news conference at senior advocate Kapil Sibal's residence, CJP spokespersons Saurav Das, Ashutosh Rana and Ratna Singh alleged that despite an in-principle agreement that no fresh FIRs would be registered against protesters and existing cases would be withdrawn, police action was continuing in several states.

"We are observing a complete breach of the agreement regarding no police action against the protesters," Rana said, adding that the organisation had submitted a written draft of the understanding and was awaiting the govt's written commitment. "If we don't get this agreement by tomorrow, and if protesters are not released across the country CJP will be forced to protest again," he said. The warning comes two days after CJP called off its protest after govt accepted its demands.

101 murder accused part of violence during July 20 Parl march: Delhi Police

New Delhi: Delhi Police said its investigation has revealed that 101 individuals with murder charges, 24 people booked in dacoity and robbery cases, and 92 accused in sexual assault and other offences against women and children were part of the violence during the protesters' march to Parliament on July 20.

Report submitted by police commissioner Anurag Kumar to the govt details how the police examined a total of 2,873 criminals involved in attacking and vandalising vehicles. Of them, 989 were found to have criminal antecedents in various offences, it said. Action, including arrest and investigation against these individuals with criminal history is likely to continue.

Mumbai: HDFC Bank's board on Monday imposed a penalty of ₹1 lakh each on managing director & CEO Sashidhar Jagdishan, chief financial officer Srinivas Vaidyanathan and group head of retail assets Arvind Vohra, and also issued warning letters following an internal review of the bank's deposit arrangements with Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation in 2017 and 2021.

The review found instances of "business overreach" but no evidence of mala fide intent or personal gain. The action was based on the recommendations of a special disciplinary committee of independent directors, with other employees involved also receiving warning letters. Bankers said while the penalty was nominal, a public, board-backed censure on sitting MD & CEO, framed as

The plea, once rare and awkward, is becoming increasingly common on LinkedIn and Reddit, where freshers and early-career professionals are promising their first pay cheque—or even cash incentives—for referrals that could open the door to jobs.
